The Post attended the Dist. 12 meeting on March 14th, we had 6 members present. The Commander received all the awards the Post received. It was an interesting meeting.

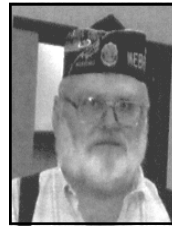
